

**Individual Narrative of David<sup>7</sup> Johnson Hedenberg [151]**  
**Son of James VanAlst Hedenberg and Elizabeth<sup>6</sup> Leverich [61]**  
**Husband of Catherine Ann Ritchie**  
**Husband of Martha Alvord Graves (Miles)**

David Johnson Hedenberg was born on 27 Nov 1802 at Newtown, Queens Co, New York, the son of James Van Alst Hedenberg and Elizabeth Leverich. The birth date is a calculated date based upon David's age at the time he died.<sup>1</sup>

In a deed dated 31 May 1828, in consideration of \$700.00, Eliakim and Sarah Meeker of Troy, Rensselaer Co, New York sold land at Troy to David J. Hedenberg of Troy. The property was described as "all and singular the equal ... half part of all that certain lot piece or parcel of land situate lying and being in the City of Troy ... aforesaid and known and distinguished on a certain map of the same by lot number 444 and bounded as follows via west by Fifth St, North by Lot number 445, east by an alley twenty feet side and south by a line through the middle of the said lot number 444 being 25 ft wide front and rear and 130 ft long ... Subject nevertheless to the payment of yearly rent of \$12.50 reserved to be charged upon the said lot in and by the original lease from Jacob D. Vanderhyden ..." David J. Hedenberg sold this property to John R. Kimberly 1 March 1844, see Liber 60, page 81.<sup>2,3</sup>

The 1859 Troy City Directory includes a list of Troy residents in 1829 that survived in 1859. This list included David J. Hedenberg, coachmaker, 110 Fifth Street.<sup>4</sup>

David J. Hedenberg married K(C)atherine Ann Ritchie circa 1830 at Troy, Rensselaer, New York. The marriage date is an estimate based upon the 1831 birth date of their first child.<sup>5,6</sup>

Katherine Ann Ritchie was born 15 July 1804, perhaps at Troy, Rensselaer Co, New York. Neither the names of Katherine's parents nor her place of birth have been identified.<sup>7</sup> Katherine Ann (Ritchie) Hedenberg died at Troy 8 July 1834 and was buried at Old Mount Ida Cemetery in Troy.<sup>8</sup>

David J. Hedenberg and Katherine Ann Ritchie had two children, one of whom survived to adulthood.<sup>9,10</sup>

- i. James Hedenberg was born 20 June 1831 at Troy, Rensselaer Co, New York. James married 6 February 1855 at Troy Emma Sarah Ball, the daughter of Sylvester C. Ball, who was a partner of James' father David J. Hedenberg in the coachmaking business. Both David and Emma were living in Troy with their respective parents in the 1850 U.S. Census. James studied medicine in the old Castleton (VT) medical school and practiced medicine at Troy until relocating to Medford, Middlesex County, Massachusetts in July 1855 (not 1854 as recorded in his obituary). James became estranged from his father because he chose medicine as a career, when his father had planned for him to study for the ministry. James and Emma were enumerated in the 1855 New York State Census on 14 June 1855, and the 1855 Massachusetts State Census on 28 August 1855. James and his family are recorded in the U.S. Census for the years 1860, 1870, 1880, and 1900 all at Medford, Massachusetts. James died at Medford 25 July 1905 and was buried at the Oak Grove Cemetery.<sup>11,12,13,14,15,16,17,18,19</sup>
- ii. Ritchie Hedenberg was born at Troy 24 May 1834, and died as a young child 27 July 1835. He was buried at the Old Mount Ida Cemetery in Troy.<sup>20</sup>

The following notice was published in the *Troy Daily Whig* on 19 March 1838. "The subscribers having formed a copartnership under the firm of HEDENBERG & SAGENDORF, inform the public in general that they have taken the Carriage Shops, No. 15 Ferry Street, between River and First Streets, intend carrying on the CARRIAGE MAKING BUSINESS in all its branches. From personal experience and close attention, they hope to merit a share of public patronage. POST COACHES made to order. N.B. Particular attention paid to repairing Carriages of all kinds. DAVID J. HEDENBERG, NICHOLAS SAGENDORF.<sup>21</sup>

D. J. Hedenberg is recorded in the 1840 U.S. Census of Troy, Ward 2, Rensselaer Co, New York. The census tallies include 1 free white male age 5 to 9 (son James); 1 free white male age 15 through 19 (unidentified, perhaps a coachmaking apprentice); 1 free white male age 30 to 39 (David J. Hedenberg); and 1 free white female age 50 to 59 (unidentified).<sup>22</sup>

The following notice was published in the *Troy Daily Budget* on 12 July 1842: "COPARTNERSHIP CARRIAGE MAKING. The undersigned having formed a copartnership under the name and firm of Ball & Hedenberg, intend carrying on the Carriage Making Business at the old stand, at the intersection of Division with Fourth street. N.B. Repairing done with neatness and dispatch. SYLVESTER C. BALL, DAVID J. HEDENBERG.<sup>23</sup>"

In a deed dated 1 March 1844, in consideration of \$3300.00, John R. and Aurelia Kimberly of Troy sold land in Ward 1 of Troy to David J. Hedenberg of Troy. The property was described as follows. "All that certain lot piece or parcel of land situate lying and being in the first ward of the City of Troy aforesaid commonly known and distinguished on a certain map made by John E. Van Alen the tenth day of May in the year 1793 by the description of Lot number two (2) lying East of Hill street bounded north by Lot number One. East by an alley twenty feet wide south by lot number three, and west by Hill Street, being 129 feet long and 50 feet wide in front and rear be the same more or less. Subject to an annual rent of \$10.00 reserved out of any charges on said lot in and by a certain indenture made the 12 August 1806 between John Schuyler Jun Peter S. Schuyler and Philip A. Schuyler of the first part and Gilbert Reily of the second part and payable to the said parties of the first part to said Indenture their heirs and assigns forever.

"Also all that piece or parcel of land situate in said city of Troy known as part of Lot number one Hill Street on the general map of said City above mentioned and is bounded as follows to wit: Southerly by Lot number Two (above conveyed) Northerly by the remaining part of said lot number one. Easterly by an alley and westerly by fourth street 10.5 ft and by Hill St 30 ft, being four feet wide on the alley; 130 ft long on its northerly line and 126 ft long on its southerly line. Subject to the payment to George Tebbits his heirs and assigns of five dollars annual ground rent this last described piece of property being the same conveyed to the said John R. Kimberly by ... trustees of certain creditors of the estate of Walter R. Morris deceased by deed dated 5 September 1842 and recorded ... Liber 56 page 485 book of deeds. Said first above described piece of land is hereby conveyed also subject to a mortgage for \$1,000 recorded in Book of Mortgages Liber 1 page 137 ..."

On the same date David J. Hedenberg sold property he purchased in 1828 from Elakim and Sarah Meeker (Liber 31, page 406) to John R. Kimberly (Liber 60, page 81).<sup>24,25,26</sup>

In a deed dated 27 July 1844, John and Phebe Blackburne of New Providence, Essex County, New Jersey sold a lot to David J. Hedenberg of Troy, Rensselaer Co, New York, in consideration of \$1.00, the said lot being located in Newark, Essex Co, New Jersey, beginning at Ephraim Bolles' corner on the south side of Mechanic Street. The 1843-1844 Newark City Directory lists Ephraim Bolles living at 261 Broad Street. In a deed dated 29 July 1845, David J. Hedenberg of Troy, New York sold the same lot in consideration of \$1250.00 to Aaron M. Rodwell and Stephen B. Sauders of Newark. This transaction was recorded on 2 September 1845.<sup>27,28,29</sup>

David J. Hedenberg married for a second time Martha Alvord Graves on 16 Apr 1846 at Troy, Rensselaer, New York. Martha was the daughter of Horace Graves and Martha Alvord, born in Massachusetts 9 February 1815; and the widow of John D. Miles whom she had married 16 April 1834. By her first marriage, Martha had three children, one of whom John D. Miles Jr. survived to adulthood.<sup>30,31,32,33,34,35</sup>

The following notice was published in the *Troy Northern Budget* on 29 June 1847. "Mechanic's Humane Association. The members of this association are requested to attend a meeting at the Court House to-morrow (Tuesday) evening at 7 1/2 o'clock for the purpose of making arrangements to unite in the celebration of the coming 4th. Mechanics generally, of the different occupations, that are not members, are respectfully invited to attend and co-operate in any arrangements that may be made. DAVID J. HEDENBERG, Sec.<sup>36</sup>"

David J. Hedenberg, age 49, carriage maker, is recorded in the 1850 U.S. Census of Troy, Ward 1, Rensselaer Co, New York. Other members of the household included his wife Martha A. Hedenberg, age 34; his son James Hedenberg, age 19, clerk; John Miles, step-son, age 13; son Warren Hedenberg, age 2; and infant daughter Martha E. Hedenberg.<sup>37</sup>

In a deed dated 13 June 1851, in consideration of \$900.00, Henry Nazgro and wife Eliza sold land in Troy to Sylvester C. Ball and David J. Hedenberg, described as follows: "Northern half of lot 293, bounded on the east by Fourth Street, bounded on the north by lot 294, 126 ft from street to alley, by 25 Ft front and rear." The 1857 Troy City Directory includes a listing for Sylvester C. Ball, coachman and carriage maker, 189 Fourth Street, house 179 Fourth Street.<sup>38,39</sup>

David J. Hedenberg, age 53, carriage manufacturer, is recorded in the 1855 New York State Census of Troy, Ward 1, Rensselaer Co, New York. Other members of the household included his wife Martha A. Hedenberg, age 40; step-son John D. Miles, age 18; son Warren Hedenberg, age 7; daughter Martha E., age 5; and daughter Tellazeal, age 3.<sup>40</sup>

The following notices were published in the *Troy Daily Whig* on 20 April 1855.

"DISSOLUTION, COPARTNERSHIP heretofore existing between the subscribers was dissolved by mutual consent on the 3rd instant. The books will remain at the old stand, and will be settled by James (error in newspaper, actually David) Hedenberg, to whom all accounts may be paid, and all bills presented. Troy, April 11, 1855. SYLVESTER C. BALL, DAVID J. HEDENBERG."

"COPARTNERSHIP. THE UNDERSIGNED have this day entered into a copartnership under the name of D. J. Hedenberg and Brother, and will continue the Carriage Making and Repairing Business at the old stand, where by strict attention to business, they hope to merit a continuance of the patronage of their old customers and the public in general. Troy, April 11, 1855. DAVID J. HEDENBERG, RICHARD L. HEDENBERG. N B-- Coach Painting and Varnishing on the premises by Jesse Brown.<sup>41</sup>"

In a deed dated 23 April 1856 David J. and Martha Hedenberg of Troy, Rensselaer Co, New York sold a lot in consideration of \$450.00 to James Galbraith of Newark, Essex Co, New Jersey, said lot located in Newark on the west side of High Street, forty feet south of the corner of Warren Street. The deed was recorded in Rensselaer Co, New York on 23 April 1856, and received by the Essex County, New Jersey Clerk on 3 May 1856. This conveyance was made subject to a mortgage given by William Picket and wife and Richard L. Hedenberg to Henry Alling for \$500.00 28 April 1836.<sup>42</sup>

The Troy City Directory for the years 1857 to 1862 include the following listing: David J. Hedenberg, coach maker, 1 Hill, house the same; Mrs. David J. Hedenberg, variety store, 1 Hill, house the same.<sup>43,44,45,46,47,48</sup>

Two deeds, both dated 23 February 1858, each sell land at Troy as follows: David J. Hedenberg and wife Martha A. Hedenberg sell 2 Hill St Ward 1 Troy New York to Chester P. Dexter for 1 dollar. Chester P. Dexter sells 2 Hill Street Ward 1 Troy to Martha A. Hedenberg, Warren Hedenberg, Martha E. Hedenberg, and Tellazeal Hedenberg for 1 dollar. The 1857 Troy City Directory includes a listing for Chester C. Dexter, baker, 143 Fourth St, house 144 Fourth St.<sup>49,50,51</sup>

David J. Hedenberg, age 58, fancy store, is recorded in the 1860 U.S. Census, Troy, Ward 1, Rensselaer Co, New York. The household included a listing for Catherine Groves, age 44. The Catherine Groves listing would appear to be a recording error for Martha A. Hedenberg. The household also included children Warren Hedenberg, age 13; Martha Hedenberg, age 10; and Tellazeal Hedenberg, age 8.<sup>52</sup>

The 1863-1865 Troy City Directories include the following listing: David J. Hedenberger, coachmaker, house 1 Hill. The earlier listing for a variety store is not included.<sup>53,54,55</sup>

David J. Hedenberg, age 64, carriage maker, is recorded in the 1865 New York State Census of Troy, Ward 1, Rensselaer Co, New York. Other members of the household included his wife Martha A. Hedenberg, age 50; his son Warren Hedenberg, age 17; his daughter Martha E. Hedenberg, age 15; and his daughter Tellazeal Hedenberg, age 13.<sup>56</sup>

The 1866-1868 Troy City Directories include the following listing: David J. Hedenberg, coachmaker, house 1 Hill; Mrs. D. J. Hedenberg, drugs 1 Hill, house the same.<sup>57,58,59</sup> The 1869-1871 Troy City Directories include the following listing: David J. Hedenberg, coachmaker, house 1 Hill; Mrs. D. J. Hedenberg, drugs 1 Hill, house the same; Martha E. Hedenberg, Teacher 7th Ward School, boards 1 Hill; Warren Hedenberg, clerk, Congress corner Fifth, boards 1 Hill.<sup>60,61,62</sup>



D. (David J.) Hedenberg, age 68, no occupation given, is recorded in the 1870 U.S. Census of Troy, Ward 1, Rensselaer Co, New York. Other members of the household included wife M. (Martha A.) Hedenberg, age 58; son Warren Hedenberg, age 23; daughter Martha Hedenberg, age 20; daughter Telazeal Hedenberg, age 18. Also living in the

household is Dexter Miles, age 5. Dexter was the grandson of Martha Hedenberg, wife of D. Hedenberg, by her first marriage, the son of her son John D. Miles, Jr. In the 1880 census, Dexter, age 16, is living with his parents John and Mary Miles in Troy.<sup>63,64</sup>

The 1872 Troy City Directory included the following listings: David J. Hedenberg, coachmaker, house 1 Hill; Martha E. Hedenberg, teacher 7th Ward School, boards 1 Hill; Warren Hedenberg (Dorr & Hedenberg), carriage trimmers, 202 Fourth, boards 1 Hill; Dorr, Hiram H., carriage trimmer 112 sixth, also: Dorr and Hedenberg, carriage trimmers 202 Fourth, boards 92 Fourth.<sup>65</sup>

The following notice was published in the *Troy Daily Times* on 8 July 1872. "July 1, 1872 -- Hon T.B. Carroll, Mayor: the undersigned residents of that part of the city of Troy near Liberty square would most respectfully ask his Honor to prevent in the future street preaching on the square every Sunday, as it is a cause of great annoyance to the adjoining residents, causing, as it does, quarrels, shouting, hurraing, and cursing ... and as in duty bound, your petitioners pray etc." Signed Warren Hedenberg, Mrs. David J. Hedenberg, and others.<sup>66</sup>

The 1873 to 1878 Troy City Directories included the following listings: David J. Hedenberg, coachmaker, house 1 Hill; Warren Hedenberg, clerk 127 Congress, boards 1 Hill.<sup>67,68,69,70,71,72</sup>

David Hedenberg, age 70, coachmaker, is recorded in the 1875 New York State Census of Troy, Rensselaer Co, New York. The household also included his wife Martha Hedenberg, age 50; son Warren Hedenberg, age 26, clerk; daughter Martha Hazer age 25, school teacher; her husband Warren Hazer, age 26, photographer; her daughter Tellazeal Hazer age 2; and his daughter Tellazeal Hedenberg, age 23.<sup>73</sup>

David J. Hedenberg died on 14 Oct 1878 at Troy, Rensselaer Co, New York, of paralysis at the age of 75 years, 10 months, 17 days. David was buried at the Oakwood Cemetery in Troy.<sup>74</sup>

The 1879 Troy City Directory included the following listings: Mrs. David J. Hedenberg, widow, house 1 Hill; Warren Hedenberg, carriage manufacturer 202 Fourth, boards 1 Hill.<sup>75</sup>

M. A. Hedenberg, age 65, born Massachusetts, widow, is recorded in the 1880 U.S. Census, residing at 1 Hill Street, Troy, Rensselaer Co, New York. The household also included son Warren Hedenberg, age 32, single, clerk in Post Office; and daughter Tellazeal Hedenberg, age 27, single, seamstress.<sup>76</sup>

The 1880 to 1885 Troy City Directories included the following listings: Mrs. Mrs. David J. Hedenberg, widow, house 1 Hill; Warren Hedenberg, clerk post office, boards 1 Hill; Miss Tellazeal Hedenberg, boards 1 Hill.<sup>77,78,79,80,81,82</sup>

The following death notice was published in the *Troy Daily Times* on 14 November 1885. "Mrs. Martha A. Hedenberg died at her residence, no 1 Hill street, last evening. She had resided in Troy fifty-three years, and had occupied for forty years the house where she died. She is survived by two sons, John D. Miles and Warren Hedenberg, and a daughter. Mrs. Hedenberg was an estimable woman." Martha A. Hedenberg was buried at the Oakwood Cemetery in Troy.<sup>83,84</sup>

The 1886 Troy City Directory records that Mrs. David J. Hedenberg died 13 November 1885. Her son Warren Hedenberg and her daughter Tellazeal Hedenberg continued to live at the family homestead located at 1 Hill St in Troy.<sup>85</sup>

Martha A. (Graves, Miles) Hedenberg made a will dated 12 September 1885, and died at 1 Hill Street in Troy 13 November 1885. A petition for probate was made 7 January 1886 by her son Warren. Predeceased by her husband, Martha was survived by her son by her first marriage John D. Miles Jr., her son and executor Warren Hedeberg, and her daughter Tellazeal Hedenberg. Also surviving was her grandson Willard (William) E. Hazer, son of her deceased daughter Martha E. Hazer, who was residing with his father Warren Hazer in Troy. Martha's will leaves her entire estate to her daughter Tellazeal. The estate papers do not mention James Hedenberg, her husband's son by his first marriage.<sup>86</sup>

David J. Hedenberg and Martha A. Graves (Miles) had three children, all born at Troy.<sup>87,88</sup>

- iii. Warren Hedenberg was born at Troy, Rensselaer Co, New York in October 1847. Warren was never married, and lived his entire life at the family homestead 1 Hill Street in Troy. Warren was a clerk in the post office, and also worked in the family coach making business. Warren died at Troy 30 August 1894 and was buried at the Oakwood Cemetery in Troy. Warren is found in the 1850, 1860, 1870, and 1880 U.S. Census of Troy; also the 1855, 1865, and 1875 New York State Census of Troy.<sup>89,90,91,92,93,94,95,96,97,98</sup>
- iv. Martha E. Hedenberg was born at Troy, Rensselaer Co, New York in November 1849. Prior to her marriage, Martha was a school teacher in the Troy Ward 7 school. Martha married Warren Hazer, a photographer, c 1872 at Troy. Martha died of typhoid fever at Troy 25 November 1876 and was buried at the Oakwood Cemetery in Troy. Elizabeth is found in the 1850, 1860, and 1870 U.S. Census of Troy; and the 1865 and 1875 New York State Census of Troy. In the 1880 U.S. Census of Troy, Martha's only child Willard Hazer is living with his grandmother Elvira A. Hazer in Troy. His father Warren Hazer was boarding at Johnstown, Fulton Co, New York in 1880.<sup>99,100,101,102,103,104,105,106,107,108,109,110,111,112,113,114,115</sup>
- v. Tellazeal Hedenberg was born at Troy, Rensselaer Co, New York about 1853. Tellazeal never married, worked as a seamstress, and lived at the family homestead 1 Hill Street in Troy her entire lifetime. Tellazeal died at Troy 26 March 1903 and was buried at Oakwood Cemetery Troy. Tellazeal is found in the 1860, 1870, and 1880 U.S. Census of Troy; as well as the 1865 and 1875 New York State Census of Troy. She is not found in the 1900 U.S. Census.<sup>116,117,118,119,120,121,122,123,124</sup>
