

## **Individual Narrative of Ann<sup>7</sup> Catherine Riker [176] Daughter of Daniel Riker and Deborah<sup>6</sup> Leverich [64]**

Ann Catherine Riker was born on 1 May 1803 at Newtown, Queens Co, New York, the daughter of Daniel Riker and Deborah Leverich.<sup>1,2,3</sup> Ann Catherine was baptized 3 July 1803 at the Newtown Dutch Reformed Church.<sup>4</sup>

Ann Catherine died unmarried on 31 Oct 1826 probably at Newtown, Queens Co, New York, at age 23. Ann Catherine was buried at the Riker Family Burial Ground at Bowery Bay.<sup>5,6,7,8</sup>
