

**Individual Narrative of William⁸ Henry Bonnett [240]
Son of Patience⁷ Leverich [124] and Peter Bonnett
Husband of Margaret Ann Rumsey**

William Henry Bonnett was born on 1 February 1830 at Manhattan, New York Co, New York. William was the son of Peter Bonnett and Patience Leverich.^{1,2}

William H. Bonnett, age 20, single, a merchant is listed in the household of his mother Patience Bonnett in the 1850 U.S. Census of Manhattan, Ward 3, New York County, New York. The household also included his sister Mary E., age 24, and her husband George E. Vanderburgh, and his sister Caroline E., age 22, and her husband John Wilmarth, and his sister Jane Bonnett, age 28 and then unmarried.³

The 1855 New York State Census included William H. Bonnett, age 24, single, and a merchant in Ward 18 of Manhattan, New York County, New York. His mother Patience Bonnett age 69 remains the head of household. The household also includes William's sister Mary and her husband George Vanderburgh.⁴

The 1856-1858 New York City and Business Directory listed William H. Bonnett, fancy goods 74 Warren Street in Manhattan, home 56 East 21st Street in Manhattan.^{5,6,7}

On 1 May 1857 Patience Bonnett of Manhattan, New York Co, New York leased to her son William H. Bonnett an 82 acre farm in Mamaroneck, Westchester Co, New York in consideration of an annual rent of \$1190. This property was sold to Patience Bonnett by Susan Dusenbury on 23 April 1857, Liber 356 page 184. The property was described as lying on the northerly side of the turnpike road and bounded on the west by the Quaker burying ground. The indenture was recorded 30 October 1858.⁸

William H. Bonnett was married to Margaret Ann Rumsey on 27 May 1857 at New Rochelle, Westchester County, New York, by the Rev. Chas. E. Lindsay. Margaret, born 14 December 1837 in Eastchester, Westchester Co, New York, was the eldest daughter of the then late Thomas Osborn Rumsey and Matilda Earle of New Rochelle.^{9,10,11,12,13}

William H. Bonnett was listed in the 1859 New York City Directory, imp. 74 Warren, home 56 East 21st Street.¹⁴

William H. Bonnett, Gentleman age 30 with real estate valued at \$25,000 and personal estate valued at \$5000 was recorded in the 1860 U.S. Census of Mamaroneck, Westchester County, New York. The household included William's wife Margaret Bonnett age 22 and their daughter Louise Bonnett age 2.¹⁵

The 1861-1864 New York City Directories recorded William H. Bonnett, clerk at 123 Malden Lane in Manhattan, residence in New Rochelle, Westchester County, New York.^{16,17,18,19}

On 15 November 1866 Margaret A. Bonnett of New Rochelle, Westchester Co, New York; daughter of Thomas O. Rumsey deceased, and her husband William H. Bonnett sold land in New Rochelle to Cornelius E. Rumsey, in consideration of \$1000; which land was part of the estate of Thomas O. Rumsey granted to his daughter Margaret as per his last will and testament. The deed was recorded on 16 November 1866.²⁰

William H. Bonnett, book keeper age 40 was recorded in the 1870 U.S. Census of New Rochelle, Westchester County, New York. The household included William's wife Margaret Bonnett age 32 and their children Louise E. age 12, Edward M. age 6, Clarence age 4, and Edith age 3.²¹

William H. Bonnett was appointed to serve on the Grand Jury at the court house in White Plains, Westchester County, New York beginning 19 November 1877.²²

William H. Bonnett, retired merchant age 50 was recorded in the 1880 U.S. Census of New Rochelle, Westchester County, New York. The household included William's wife Margaret Bonnett age 42 and their children Louise E. age 21, Edward M. age 16, Clarence age 14, Edith age 13, and Marguerite W. age 3.²³

By 1883 William H. Bonnett had removed to Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, a book keeper, 45 Western Avenue.²⁴

On 25 February 1885 John and Caroline E. (Bonnett) Wilmarth of New Rochelle, Westchester Co, NY; Mary E. (Bonnett) Vanderburgh widow of Mamaroneck, Westchester Co; and William H. and Margaret A. Bonnett of Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania granted a 7.5 acre tract of land at New Rochelle known as the "Fields" of which Jane (Bonnett) Fields died possessed in consideration of \$1.00 to Philip R. Underhill, grantee. This tract of land bordered easterly by the property of John Haskill, Adrean ?aelin Jr.; northerly by the property of Deborah Rhinelander now of H? Iselin; westerly by the property late of Richard King and James Dusenbury; and southerly by the Pelham Road. The deed was recorded 6 May 1885.²⁵

A "dollar deed" represents a transaction whereby people or even corporations can often deed a piece of property to a new owner for just one dollar. This type of deed transfer is also known as a quitclaim deed. One party "quits" the ownership of the property in favor of bestowing it upon someone else. The one-dollar phrase is the recital in the deed that confirms for every reader of the deed that the buyer gave the seller consideration, which is the at-least nominal consideration of one dollar, which is all that the law requires.²⁶

The 1890 Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania City Directory listed William H. Bonnett, book keeper, S.S. Marvin & Co. (brother-in-law Sylvester Stephen Marvin, husband of Edith Bonnett), home 39 Windsor.²⁷

On 24 February 1890 William H. Bonnett the sole surviving executor of the Last Will and Testament of Peter Bonnett deceased sold to Caroline E. Wilmarth of the Town of New Rochelle County of Westchester and State of New York ... in consideration of the sum of \$18,000 ...all that certain tract of land situated ... at Chatsworth in the Town of Mamaroneck County of Westchester ...bounded and described as following, to wit: Beginning at the northeasterly corner of the said tract of land being at a point on the northwesterly side of the New York and Boston Turnpike Road where the same is intersected by the boundary line of land now or late of Theodore E. Tomlinson running thence along said road ... 1017 feet to the center line of an avenue called Chatsworth Avenue thence along the said center line of said avenue ... 1175 feet to a line which was the center line of a certain strip of land intended for a street or road to be laid out and called Roosevelt Avenue but now discontinued ... on a line which was the center of said strip of land intended for a street and along a line in continuation thereof 1213 feet to land now or later of Thomas Palmer thence along said land ... 190 feet thence 535 feet thence ... along the land now or late of Theodore E. Tomlinson 375 feet to place of beginning containing 28 acres. Being the same premises which were conveyed to Mary E. Vanderburgh by James J. Roosevelt and Cornelia his wife by deed dated the 16th of June 1854 and recorded ... 20 June 1854.

And also all those certain several pieces or parcels of land situate in the Town of Mamaroneck aforesaid and being known by lot numbers 10, 11, 18, 9, 12, 17, and 20 on a map of property belonging to George R. Jackson and Thaddeus David called Chatsworth laid out and surveyed by William Breyson Civil Engineer 15 June 1854 and filed or to be filed in the office of the Clerk of Westchester County which ... parcels of land taken together are bounded and described as follows, to wit: Beginning at a point on the northeasterly side of Chatsworth Ave adjoining the land conveyed to the said Mary E. Vanderburgh by James J Roosevelt and wife being at the point where the said northeasterly line of Chatsworth Avenue is intersected by the center line of a strip of land intended for a street or Avenue laid down on said map and therein called Roosevelt Ave (but which said avenue is now discontinued) continued thence northwesterly along the northeasterly side of Chatsworth Ave 1330 feet to the point where the center line of the said strip of land called Roosevelt Avenue on said map again intersects the northeasterly line of Chatsworth Avenue then northeasterly and Easterly in a continuing line along the said center line of the said strip of land called Roosevelt Ave as laid down on said map 516 feet to a point where the said center line would intersect the Easterly line of lot number 9 on the said map if the same were continued to the center of said avenue; thence northeasterly in a straight line across the said avenue and along the Easterly side of lot number 19, 777 feet to the land of the said Thomas Palmer, 1102 feet to the land conveyed by said Roosevelt and wife to said Mary E. Vanderburgh; thence southwesterly along the said last mentioned land running part of the way the center of the said strip of land called Roosevelt Ave; 1173 feet ... to the northeasterly side of Chatsworth Ave at the place of beginning containing within said ... 33 acres ...

... and also all the right title and interest of the party of the first part of in and to the land in Chatsworth Ave lying in front of the above described premises to the center of said avenue excepting there from the following described premises as follows: Beginning at a point formed by the intersection of Collins Ave or Larchmont Ave the same being the street or avenue on which the horse railway now ... and Chatsworth Ave and running thence southeasterly by and with Chatsworth Ave 1100 feet running thence northeasterly and at right angles to Chatsworth Ave 425 feet; running thence northwesterly

and parallel with Chatsworth Ave 425 feet; thence northwesterly and parallel with Chatsworth Ave to the lands of the Larchmont Manor Company; and running thence southwesterly by and with the lands of the Larchmont Manor Co to the point and place of beginning. Being the same premises conveyed to the said party of the first part by Thomas Halstead Referee by deed dated 20 February 1890 (end of page 359) ... (page 360 not transcribed) ... The deed was recorded 25 February 1890.²⁸

On 13 April 1892 William H. Bonnett and his wife Margaret A. of Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania granted land at Mamaroneck, Westchester Co, New York to his sister Caroline E. (Bonnett) Wilmarth, in consideration of \$1.00. The tract of land consisted 41.8 acres of land encompassing lots 1, 10, 11, 18 and bordering the estates of Thomas Palmer and Theodore Tomlinson, as well as the Boston Post Road, Chatsworth Avenue, and Roosevelt Avenue. The deed was recorded 6 June 1892.²⁹

The 1895 Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania City Directory listed William H. Bonnett, clerk, home 39 Windsor.³⁰

Margaret Rumsey Bonnett, the wife of William H. Bonnett, died 24 April 1898 at Pittsburgh, Allegheny Co, Pennsylvania. Her funeral was held from the family residence at 5718 Howe St in Pittsburgh. Margaret was buried at Homewood Cemetery in Pittsburgh.^{31,32}

William H. Bonnett, bakery clerk, age 70 was recorded in the 1900 U.S. Census of Pittsburgh, Ward 20, Allegheny Co, Pennsylvania, living at 5718 Howe Street. The household included William's daughter Marguerite W. Bonnett age 23.³³

The 1900 Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania City Directory listed William H. Bonnett, book keeper 409 Liberty Avenue, home 39 Windsor.³⁴

The 1906 Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania City Directory listed William H. Bonnett, salesman, home 5718 Howe.³⁵

The 1910 U.S. Census recorded William H. Bonnett, gentleman farmer, age 80 living at Canton New Berlin Road, Town of Plain, Stark County, Ohio. William is living with his daughter Louise E. Bonnett Bates, age 52; and his granddaughter Louise E. Bates, age 25.³⁶

William Henry Bonnett died on 21 December 1911 at Coconino County, Arizona, at the Grand Canyon where he had stopped while on his way to Riverside, California to visit his son Edward M. Bonnett. William was initially interred in Riverside, but subsequently reinterred at Homewood Cemetery in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania.^{37,38,39}

William Henry Bonnett and Margaret Ann Rumsey had eight children, five of whom survived to adulthood.⁴⁰

- i. Louise Earle Bonnett was born 14 March 1858 in Manhattan, New York Co, New York. Louise was listed in the 1880 U.S. Census of New Rochelle, Westchester Co, New York, age 21. Louise Bonnett married Henry Whitney Bates 28 September 1882 in Emsworth, Allegheny Co, Pennsylvania. Louise was listed in the 1900 U.S. Census of Manhattan, New York Co, New York, age 40. Louise was listed in the 1910 U.S. Census of Plain, Stark Co, Ohio, age 52. Louise was listed in the 1920 U.S. Census of Canton, Ward 7, Stark Co, Ohio. Louise Bonnett Bates died 18 March 1921 in Riverside, Riverside Co, California while visiting her brother Edward M. Bonnett. Louise was buried at the St. James the Less Episcopal Church in Scarsdale, Westchester Co, New York.^{41,42,43,44,45,46,47,48,49,50,51}
- ii. Grace Berrian Bonnett was born 31 August 1860 in Manhattan, New York Co, New York. Grace died as a child 17 December 1862 in New Rochelle, Westchester Co, New York. Grace was buried in Green-wood Cemetery, Brooklyn, Kings Co, New York.^{52,53,54,55}
- iii. William Henry Bonnett Jr was born 20 January 1862 in New Rochelle, Westchester Co, New York. William died as a child 3 January 1863 in New Rochelle. William was buried in Green-wood Cemetery, Brooklyn, Kings Co, New York.^{56,57,58,59}
- iv. Edward Mortimer Bonnett Sr. was born 18 May 1864 in New Rochelle, Westchester Co, New York. Edward was living with his parents, age 16, in the 1880 U.S. Census of New Rochelle. Edward Bonnett married Lucy Bates 3 June 1890 at the Church of the Holy Trinity in Manhattan, New York Co, New York. Edward was listed in the

1900 U.S. Census of Collingwood, Cuyahoga County, Ohio age 36 Manufacturer Baker. Edward was listed in the 1910 U.S. Census of Canton, Ward 1, Stark Co, Ohio age 45 President Baking Company. Edward was listed in the 1920 U.S. Census of Riverside, Ward 2, Riverside Co, California age 55 Barber. Edward was listed in the 1930 U.S. Census of Riverside, Riverside Co, California age 65 farmer. Edward died 20 November 1930 in Riverside. Edward was buried in Olivewood Cemetery in Riverside.^{60,61,62,63,64,65,66,67,68}

- v. Clarence Roosevelt Bonnett was born 16 September 1865 in New Rochelle, Westchester Co, New York. Clarence was living with his parents, age 14, in the 1880 U.S. Census of New Rochelle. Clarence married Lila M. Ruch 1 June 1899 in Allegheny Co, Pennsylvania. Clarence was listed in the 1900 U.S. Census of Morgan, Morgan Co, Ohio age 33 Manager Mill Flour. Clarence was listed in the 1910 U.S. Census of Pittsburgh, Ward 4, Allegheny Co, Pennsylvania age 44 Bookkeeper. Clarence was listed in the 1920 U.S. Census of Pittsburgh, Ward 14, Allegheny Co, Pennsylvania age 50 Baker. Clarence died 23 September 1928 in Lower Merion, Montgomery Co, Pennsylvania. Clarence was buried at St. Peter's Cemetery in Pittsburgh, Allegheny Co, Pennsylvania.^{69,70,71,72,73,74,75,76}
- vi. Edith Bonnett was born 6 September 1866 in New Rochelle, Westchester Co, New York. Edith was living with her parents, age 13, in the 1880 U.S. Census of New Rochelle. Edith married Sylvester Stephen Marvin 27 May 1897 at the Presbyterian Church of Catasaqua, Lehigh Co, Pennsylvania. Edith was listed in the 1900 U.S. Census of Philadelphia, Ward 22, Philadelphia Co, Pennsylvania with her husband Sylvester S. Marvin. Edith was listed in the 1910, 1920, and 1930 U.S. Census of Lower Merion, Montgomery Co, Pennsylvania with her husband Sylvester. Edith was listed in the 1940 U.S. Census of Riverside, Riverside Co, California. Edith died 27 August 1944 in Orange, Orange Co, California. Edith was buried in the Olivewood Cemetery in Riverside, California.^{77,78,79,80,81,82,83,84,85,86,87,88}
- vii. Pierre Bonnett was born 17 May 1873 in New Rochelle, Westchester Co, New York. Pierre died as a child 18 July 1874 in New Rochelle. Pierre was buried in Green-wood Cemetery, Brooklyn, Kings Co, New York.^{89,90,91}
- viii. Marguerite Waldron Bonnett was born 22 January 1877 in New Rochelle, Westchester Co, New York. Marguerite was never married. Marguerite died 28 February 1914 in Los Angeles, Los Angeles Co, California. Marguerite was buried in Homewood Cemetery, Pittsburgh, Allegheny Co, Pennsylvania.^{92,93,94,95,96,97}
