

**Individual Narrative of Ellen⁸ Louisa Gorsline [246]
Daughter of Grace⁷ Riker Leverich [126] and Andrew Gorsline
Wife Robert Timpson
Wife of Moses Hoppock**

Ellen Louisa Gorsline was born on 27 August 1824 at Newtown, Queens Co, New York, the daughter of Gertrude Riker Leverich and Andrew Gorsline.¹

Ellen married Robert Timpson on 18 December 1845 at the Newtown Presbyterian Church.²

Robert M. Timpson was born 11 December 1819 in Manhattan, New York Co, New York. Robert was the son of William Timpson and Caroline Mount.³

Robert M. Timpson died 19 February 1848 in Manhattan, New York Co, New York. His funeral was held from his late residence 20 Chelsea Cottage at 24th Street. Robert was buried in Westchester County New York at an unidentified cemetery.^{4,5}

On 6 October 1848 Mrs. Ellen Louisa Timpson, Adult, was baptized at the Newtown Presbyterian Church.⁶

Ellen Louisa Gorsline and Robert M. Timpson had one child.

- i. Robert William Timpson was born in September 1847 and was baptized 22 November 1848 at the Newtown Presbyterian Church. He died as a child 21 February 1849 at Newtown.^{7,8}

Ellen Louisa Gorsline Timpson, widow, is not found in either the 1850 U.S. Census or the 1850 New York City Directory.^{9,10}

Ellen, widow Timpson, was married for a second time to Moses A. Hoppock on 23 March 1852 at the Brick Church in Manhattan, New York County, New York, by the Rev. Dr. Spring. This was also a second marriage for Moses.¹¹

Moses Allen Hoppock was born on 15 January 1817 in Hunterdon County, New Jersey, the son of Jacob Hoppock and Rachel Allen. Moses married for the first time Martha Kershaw on 20 September 1836 in Hunterdon County, New Jersey. Martha died 4 September 1847 at Ringoes, Hunterdon Co, New Jersey. Moses and Martha had three children Emma, Elizabeth, and Edward.^{12,13,14}

Ellen Louisa Gorsline Hoppock, age 35 born New York, is recorded in the 1855 New York State Census, living in Manhattan, Ward 15, New York County, New York (census recorder identifies her as "Abbert"). The household includes her husband Moses A. Hoppock, merchant age 39, born in New Jersey; step children Emma age 16, Elizabeth age 15, and Edward age 12. The census recorder also lists a child Ellen age 2; this is likely a recording error and the individual was more likely a son Albert age 2. Also included in the household is Ellen Louisa's brother Andrew Gorsline, a boarder and merchant, age 27.¹⁵

Ellen Hoppock, age 36 born New York, is recorded in the 1860 U.S. Census living in Manhattan, Ward 15, District 3, New York County, New York. The household included her husband Moses A. Hoppock (identified by the census taker as Henry) age 45, born in New Jersey, a grocer with real estate valued at \$20,000 and personal estate valued at \$20,000. The household also included step children Emma age 21, Elizabeth age 19, Edward age 12; also children Albert age 6, Walter age 4, Moses age 2, and Ella age one month.¹⁶

Moses A. Hoppock is listed in the 1862 New York City Directory, dry goods 159 Chambers and grocer 87 Warren, living at 84 West 14th Street.¹⁷

On 7 April 1862 Ellen L. Hoppock, wife of Moses A Hoppock of Manhattan, New York County, New York purchased land at Greenburgh, Westchester County, New York from Alexander H. Wallis and his wife Elizabeth of Jersey City, Hudson County, New Jersey in consideration of \$38,000. The property consisted of 18 acres at the juncture of the Old Post Road and the Highland Turnpike, adjoining the land of William A. Hall and Isaac Lafurgy.¹⁸

Moses A. Hoppock is listed in the 1863 New York City Directory, treasurer 87 Warren Street in Manhattan, New York Co, New York, living at Hastings, Westchester Co, New York.¹⁹

On 5 April 1864 Moses A. Hoppock of the village of Hastings, Greenburgh Township, Westchester Co, New York purchased seven acres of land at Hastings, from Martin L. Lafurgy and his wife Mary L., also of Hastings, in consideration of \$2,267. The tract of land was lying on the Westerly side of the Cross Road leading from the Old Highland Turnpike Road, to the Reformed Dutch Church at Hastings upon Hudson, to the Saw Mill River Road, and bordering the lands of Isaac Brown and Ellen L. Hoppock, wife of Moses.²⁰

Moses A. Hoppock is listed in the 1865 New York City Directory, a grocer at 18 Vesey Street, treasurer 18 Pine Street, living at Hastings, Westchester Co, New York.²¹

Moses A. Hoppock is listed in the 1867 New York City Directory, a grocer at 18 Vesey Street, President 70 Broadway, living at Hastings, Westchester Co, New York.²²

Ellen L. Hoppock, age 45 born New York, is recorded in the 1870 U.S. Census living in Greenburgh, Westchester Co, New York. The household included her husband Moses Hoppock age 56 born New Jersey, wholesale merchant, value of real estate \$100,000; and her step children Emma and Edward. The household also included her children Allen age 12, Ellen age 9, Arthur age 6, Grace age 5, and Ernest age 3.²³

Andrew Gorsline, the father of Ellen Louisa Gorsline, made a will 31 July 1871 at Newtown, Queens Co, New York. Among the heirs cited in the will was his daughter Ellen Louisa Hoppock, wife of Moses A. Hoppock, residing at Hastings-on-the Hudson, Westchester County, New York.²⁴

On 29 October 1872 Mrs. E. L. Hoppock arrived in New York City as a passenger on the ship Minnesota, which had departed from Liverpool, England.²⁵

Moses A. Hoppock died 1 November 1872 at Hastings-on-the Hudson, Town of Greenburgh, Westchester County, New York. He was presumably buried in Westchester County at an unidentified location.²⁶

Moses A. Hoppock of Hastings on the Hudson, Town of Greenburgh, Westchester County, New York made a will 4 November 1870. Moses appointed his loving wife Ellen L. Hoppock as one of the executors of his will. Moses' estate was proved at the Westchester Co, New York Surrogate on 22 November 1872.²⁷

On 13 March 1873, at the Westchester County, New York Surrogate, the widow Ellen L. Hoppock was granted guardianship of her minor children Ellen L., Arthur W., Grace B., Ernest L., Walter H., Albert E., and Moses A.²⁸

Ellen L. Hoppock, a widow age 56 born New York, is recorded in the 1880 U.S. Census living in Hastings-on-Hudson, Greenburgh Township, Westchester Co, New York. The household included her children Howard age 24 broker, Moses Allen age 22 broker, Ellen L. age 20, Arthur W. age 16, Gracie B age 14, and Ernest L. age 12. The household also included Ellen's sister Gertrude Gorsline age 51.²⁹

Ellen Louisa Hoppock, wife of the late Moses A. Hoppock, died on 27 January 1901 at Redlands, San Bernardino, California, at age 76.^{30,31} The 1902 Redlands, California City Directory includes a listing for Miss E. Louise Hoppock, daughter of Ellen Louisa and Moses A. Hoppock, living at 554 West Highland Avenue.³²

Ellen Louisa Gorsline and Moses A. Hoppock had seven children, all of whom survived until adulthood.³³

- i. Albert Eugene Hoppock was born 2 November 1853 in Manhattan, New York County, New York. Albert was baptized 12 March 1854 at the 5th Avenue Presbyterian Church in Manhattan. Albert married Charlotte Louise Grow circa 1875 in Manhattan. He operated a varnish factory in Manhattan. Albert died of pneumonia 12 December 1883 in Hastings-on-Hudson, Westchester County, New York.^{34,35,36,37,38,39}
- ii. Walter Howard Hoppock was born 20 May 1856 in Manhattan, New York County, New York. Walter was baptized 9 November 1856 at the 5th Avenue Presbyterian Church in Manhattan. Walter was married to Mary Moore Cooper 18 September 1883 by the Rev. George Reese of Zion Episcopal Church in Dobbs Ferry, Westchester County, New York. Walter was a broker in Manhattan and subsequently lived in Yonkers, Westchester Co, New York. Walter died 10 April 1892 of consumption in Yonkers, and was buried at the Sleepy Hollow Cemetery in Westchester County.^{40,41,42,43,44}
- iii. Moses Allen Hoppock Jr was born 17 April 1858 in Manhattan, New York Co, New York. Moses was baptized 16 August 1858 at the 5th Avenue Presbyterian Church in Manhattan. Moses married Ada Caroline Harris 17 October 1888 in Manhattan. Moses died 3 September 1946 in Westfield, Union Co, New Jersey and was buried at the Fairview Cemetery in Westfield.^{45,46,47,48}
- iv. Ellen Louise Hoppock was born 13 July 1860 in Manhattan, New York Co, New York. Ellen was baptized 12 April 1861 at the 5th Avenue Presbyterian Church in Manhattan. Ellen Louise never married and lived for a period time c 1902 in Redlands, San Bernardino Co, California. Ellen died 2 February 1930 in Siena, Italy and was buried at the Protestant Section, Misericordia Cemetery in Siena.^{49,50,51,52}
- v. Arthur Wadsworth Hoppock was born May 1864 in Hastings-on-Hudson, Westchester Co, New York. Arthur married Mary C. Stine 5 September 1888 in Ramsey Co, Minnesota. Arthur lived 1900 and 1910 in Minneapolis, Ward 4, Hennepin Co, Minnesota. Arthur lived 1914 Chelan Co, Washington. Arthur lived 1916 and 1920 in Seattle, Washington. Arthur died 24 January 1949 in Pierce Co, Washington.^{53,54,55,56,57,58,59}
- vi. Grace Berrian Hoppock was born 29 June 1865 in Hastings-on-Hudson, Westchester Co, New York. Grace never married. In 1901 Grace lived in Redlands, San Bernardino Co, California. Grace died in Redlands 7 October 1905.^{60,61,62,63}
- vii. Ernest Leverich Hoppock was born circa 1867 at Hastings-on-Hudson, Westchester Co, New York. Ernest married Daisy Belle Daniels 25 June 1890 in Yonkers, Westchester Co, New York. Ernest died 21 October 1894 in Redlands, San Bernardino Co, California. Ernest was buried either in Hastings-on-Hudson, Westchester Co (where he lived in 1880) or Rochester, Monroe Co, New York (where he lived in 1892).^{64,65,66,67}

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
