Individual Narrative of Simeon⁸ B. Leverich [258] Son of Sarah⁷ Leverich and Samuel⁷ Leverich Husband of Martha Amelia Oakley; Husband of Anna L. Gibson (Van Zandt)

Simeon B. Leverich was born on 24 January 1840 at Southport, Chemung Co, New York according to a family bible owned by Annette Leverich Phillips. He was the son of Samuel and Sarah Leverich (second cousins), for many years residents of New York City. They relocated to Southport circa 1837.^{1,2}

Simeon B. Leverich was recorded in the 1850 U.S. Census of Southport, Chemung Co, New York. Simeon, age 10, was part of the household of Samuel and Sarah Leverich. He had siblings in the household: Gabriel, age 16; Mary, age 14; and Jesse, age 12.³

Simeon B. Leverich was recorded in the 1860 U.S. Census of Southport, Chemung Co, New York. Simeon, age 17, was part of the household of Samuel and Sarah Leverich. He had siblings in the household: Gabriel, age 22; Mary, age 21; and Jesse, age 19.⁴

Samuel B. Leverich married Martha Amelia Oakley on 16 October 1861 at Southport, Chemung Co, New York.^{5,6}

Simeon B. Leverich registered for the Civil War draft in June 1863 at the age of 23 in the 27th Congressional District. At that time he was living in Elmira, Chemung Co, New York.⁷

In March 1864 Simeon B. Leverich had land in Cayuga Co, New York assessed. Simeon sold these plots of land to Nicholas S. Underwood and Margaret F. Macomber respectively.⁸

Simeon B. Leverich, age 24, is recorded in the 1865 New York State Census in Scipio, Cayuga Co, New York. Samuel's household included his wife Amelia and his daughter Margaret.⁹

In January 1868 Simeon B. Leverich sold one acre of land in Cayuga County to the Central Railroad Company.¹⁰

Simeon B. Leverich, age 35, is recorded in the 1875 New York State Census in Brooklyn, Kings Co, New York. Samuel's household included his wife Amelia, age 33, and his children Margaret, age 13; William, age 9; and Louis, age 5.¹¹

Simeon B. Leverich, age 40, was recorded in the 1880 U.S. Census of Brooklyn, Kings Co, New York. His occupation was a typesetter. He had a wife and children in the household: wife Amelia, age 38; children Margaret, age 17; William, age 15; Louis, age 10, and Amelia, age 7.¹²

Simeon B. Leverich is listed in the 1880 Brooklyn City Directory. He was a printer, and lived at 231 St. James Place.¹³

Simeon B. Leverich was listed in the New York Business Directory for 1885. His place of business as a printer was given as 51 John Street in Manhattan, New York Co, New York. His residence is recorded as 127 Cambridge Place in Brooklyn, Kings Co, New York.¹⁴

Simeon B. Leverich, printer, is listed in the 1890 Brooklyn City Directory residing at 192 McDonough St in Brooklyn.¹⁵

Simeon B. Leverich was listed in the New York Business Directory for 1895. His place of business as a printer was given as 51 John Street in Manhattan, New York Co, New York. His residence is recorded as 58 McDonough Street in Brooklyn, Kings Co, New York.¹⁶

The annual meeting of the Tompkins avenue Congregational Church was held in the parish house 18 December 1896. The Rev. Dr. Robert R. Meredith, presided. The following officers were elected; deacons included Simeon B. Leverich.¹⁷

Simeon B. Leverich, age 60, proprietor of printing office, was recorded in the 1900 Census of Brooklyn, ward 23, Kings Co, New York. His household included daughter Margaret, age 35; son William Leverich, age 34; daughter Minnie, age 24; and niece Grace Knox, age 23.¹⁸

Simeon B. Leverich, cashier, was listed in the Brooklyn City Directory in 1900 residing at 198 McDonough Street.¹⁹

Martha Amelia Oakley Leverich died at Brooklyn, Kings Co, New York on 15 June 1902. She was the first wife of Simeon B. Leverich. She was buried at Woodlawn Cemetery in Elmira, Chemung Co, New York.^{20,21}

Samuel B. Leverich married Anna L. Gibson on 27 January 1906 at Albany, Albany Co, New York.^{22,23,24,25}

Simeon B. Leverich, age 70, printer, was recorded in the 1910 U.S. Census of Mamakating, Sullivan Co, New York. Simeon's household included his second wife Anna, age 58, and three step-children.²⁶

Simeon B. Leverich is listed in the 1911 New York City Directory as President of a printing company, located at 228 Pearl Street in Manhattan, New York Co, New York.²⁷

Anna L. Gibson (Van Zandt) Leverich, second wife of Simeon B. Leverich, died 24 April 1917 at Wurtsboro, Sullivan Co, New York. She was buried at the Sylvan Cemetery in Wurtsboro.^{28,29}

Simeon B. Leverich is recorded in the 1920 U.S. Census of Wurtsboro, Sullivan Co, New York. His household included his daughter Margaret M. Leverich, age 56.³⁰

Simeon B. Leverich, age 80, is recorded in the 1925 State Census of Mamakating, Sullivan Co, New York. His household included his daughter Margaret M. Leverich, age 60.³¹

Samuel B. Leverich died on 10 November 1926 at Elmira, Chemung Co, New York, at age 86. He was buried in Woodlawn Cemetery in Emira.^{32,33,34}

Simeon B. Leverich and his first wife Margaret A. Oakley had four children, all of whom survived to adulthood.³⁵

- i. Margaret Moffet Leverich was born on 13 July 1862, probably at Southport, Chemung Co, New York according to a family bible owned by Annette Leverich Phillips. Margaret was not married. Margaret was listed in the 1880, 1900 and 1910 U.S. Census' as living in Brooklyn, Kings Co, New York; 1920 in Wurtsboro, Sullivan Co, New York; she is not found in 1930 Census; in 1940 she is listed as living in Elmira, Chemung Co, New York. Margaret was buried in Woodlawn Cemetery in Elmira.^{36,37,38,39,40,41,42,43}
- ii. William Oakley Leverich was born on 27 June 1865 in Cayuga Co, New York according to a family bible owned by Annette Leverich Phillips. William married Leticia Retons Staats on 19 April 1910 in Brooklyn, Kings Co, New York. William died 25 June 1930 in Brooklyn. He was buried at the Cypress Hills Cemetery in Brooklyn. William was recorded in the 1880, 1900, 1910, 1920, and 1930 U.S. Census', all in Brooklyn.^{44,45,46,47,48,49,50,51}
- iii. Louis Gabriel Leverich was born on 3 June 1870 in Cayuga Co, New York according to a family bible owned by Annette Leverich Phillips. Louis married Harriet Phillips 28 January 1897 in Brooklyn, Kings Co, New York. Louis died 7 December 1955 in Garden City, Nassau Co, New York. He was buried at Oak Hill Cemetery in Nyack, Rockland Co, New York. Gabriel was recorded in the 1880, 1900, 1910, and 1920 U.S Census' in Brooklyn; 1930, 1940, and 1950 in Garden City.^{52,53,54,55,56,57,58,59,60,61,62,63,64}
- iv. Martha Amelia (Minnie) Leverich was born 16 June 1873 in Brooklyn, Kings Co, New York. Martha was not married. Martha died 22 December 1904 in Brooklyn. She was buried at Woodlawn Cemetery Elmira, Chemung Co, New York. Martha was recorded in the 1880, and 1900 U.S. Census in Brooklyn.^{65,66,67,68,69}

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
