Individual Narrative of Hannah⁸ Ann Rebecca Leverich [273] Daughter of Edward⁷ Leverich Jr [133] and Hannah Underhill Wife of George M. Hyatt

Hannah Ann Rebecca Leverich was born on 3 May 1811 at Newtown, Queens County, New York.^{1,2}

Hannah A.R. Leverich married George M. Hyatt on 20 March 1838 at Newtown, Queens County, New York.^{3,4,5}

Hannah Hyatt, age 38, was recorded in the 1850 U.S. Census of Newtown, Queens County, New York. Her household included her husband George Hyatt, age 36 constable, and her son George Hyatt, age 10.⁶

Hannah Hyatt, age 48, was recorded in the 1860 U.S. Census of Newtown, Queens County, New York. Her household included her husband George Hyatt, age 46 blacksmith; and her children George E. Hyatt age 20, Mary age 14, Larry age 10, and William age 8. The younger three children did not appear in subsequent records, and likely died as children, or were adopted by their grandparents (Hannah died in 1865 and George died in 1870). However, these children are not found in the 1870 or 1880 U.S. Census.⁷

Hannah A.R. Hyatt, wife of George M. Hyatt of Newtown, is named in the will of her father, Edward Leverich Jr., dated 29 May 1855 and proved 22 January 1861.⁸

Hannah A.R. Leverich Hyatt died on 29 April 1865 at Maspeth, Queens County, New York, at age 53.9

George Hyatt, widower of Hannah A.R. Hyatt, was recorded in the 1870 U.S. Census of Newtown, Queens County, New York. George is living in the household of William and Harriett Philips. None of the children of George Hyatt are recorded in the 1870 census.¹⁰

George M. Hyatt died in March 1871 at Maspeth, Queens County, New York, age 57.11

George E. Hyatt petitioned the Queens County Surrogate 1 April 1872 to be appointed administrator of the estate of his father George M. Hyatt. George E. Hyatt identified himself as the sole person interested in the estate.¹²

Hannah A.R. Leverich and George M. Hyatt had four children, one of whom survived to adulthood.^{13,14}

George Edward Hyatt, an insurance broker, was born circa 1840 at Newtown, Queens County, New York. He died 4 May 1904 at Manhattan, New York County, New York. He was buried at the Woodlawn Cemetery in the Bronx, New York Co, New York. A spouse has not been identified for George E. Hyatt. A George Hyatt, age 38, not specifically identified as George E. Hyatt, was recorded in the 1880 U.S. Census of Manhattan, New York County, New York. George was recorded as age 38 (born circa 1842), a piano maker, with a wife Mary and a son Claude.^{15,16}
