## Individual Narrative of Mary<sup>8</sup> Gertrude Moffet [265] Daughter of Mary<sup>7</sup> Bonnett Leverich [132] and John Moffet Wife of Linson D. Fredricks

Mary Gertrude Moffet was born on 17 June 1829 at Manhattan, New York County, New York.<sup>1</sup>

Mary G. Moffet, age 20, was recorded in the 1850 U.S. Census of Manhattan, Ward 8, New York County, New York. Her mother, Mary B. Moffet, age 47, is included in the household, as well as her husband John Moffet, the head of household, and multiple siblings of Mary.<sup>2</sup>

Mary G. Moffet married Linson D. Fred(e)ricks on 27 March 1854 at Manhattan, New York, New York,

Linson D. Fred(e)ricks was born 25 January 1825 in Manhattan. His parents have not been identified. His surname is spelled both with and without the "e" after the "d" and before the "r". However, Linson signed his passport application in 1884 without including the "e, as did his son Percy.<sup>5,6</sup>

Mary G. Fredricks, age 29, was recorded in the 1860 U.S. Census of Manhattan, Ward 8, District 1, New York Co, New York. The head of household was her husband Linson D. Fredricks, age 34, photographer. The household also included sons William, age 4; and Charles, age 2; as well as one servant.<sup>7</sup>

Linson D. Fredricks is listed in the 1868 New York City Directory, a photographer living at 949 Broadway.8

Mary G. Fredricks died on 17 April 1870 at Manhattan, New York County, New York, at age 40.9,10,11

Linson D. Fredrick's family is not found in the 1870 U. S. Census. Linson D. Fredricks is listed in the 1872 New York City Directory living at 585 Broadway. 12

About 1874 Linson D. Fredricks married for a second time Charlotte Antoinette Cox. He fathered 4 children by his first marriage, and 6 children by his second marriage. <sup>13</sup>

Linson D. Fredricks, age 53, is recorded in the 1880 U.S. Census of Brooklyn, Kings County, New York. He was a liquor dealer living at 83 Magnolia Street. His household included his second wife Charlotte, age 43, as well as 4 children from his first marriage (William, Charles, Eugenie, Percy) and 2 children from his second marriage (Gertrude and Allison).<sup>14</sup>

Linson D. Fredricks died 9 August 1893 at Brooklyn, Kings County, New York. 15

Mary Gertrude Moffet and Linson D. Fredricks had four children, three of whom survived to adulthood. 16

William Henry Fredricks was born 14 February 1855 in Manhattan, New York County, New York. William was never married. William died 24 August 1909 in St. Paul, Ramsey County, Minnesota. His burial place is unknown. William was recorded in the 1880 U.S. Census of Brooklyn, Kings Co, New York. William was not found in the 1900 U.S. Census. 17,18,19

Charles L. Fredricks was born in November 1857 at Manhattan, New York County, New York. Charles was never married. Charles died 7 June 1930 at Brooklyn, Kings County, New York. He was buried at Evergreen Cemetery in Brooklyn. Charles is recorded in the 1880, 1900, 1920, and 1930 U.S. Census' of Brooklyn. Charles is not found in the 1910 U.S. Census. 20,21,22,23,24,25

Eugenie Bonnett Fredricks was born in March 1865 at Manhattan, New York Co, New York. Eugenie married John Guion Whittaker circa 1885, place unknown. She married second Charles M. Potterdon in 1917 in New Jersey. Eugenie died 3 April 1919 at Paterson, Passaic County, New Jersey. She was buried at Fair Lawn Memorial Cemetery in Bergen County, New Jersey. Eugenie was recorded in the 1880 U.S. Census of Brooklyn, Kings County, New York; the 1900 and 1910 U.S. Census' of Manchester and Hawthorne, Passaic County. New Jersey. 26,27,28,29,30,31

Percy L. Fredricks was born 6 August 1868 at Manhattan, New York County, New York. On 13 September 1884 Percy made application for a passport. He spelled his surname "Fredricks". Percy never married. Percy died 25 October 1885 at Guane Bemates, Cuba. His burial place is unknown. Percy was recorded in the 1880 U.S. Census of Brooklyn, Kings County, New York. 32,33,34
