

Individual Narrative of Jasper Strong Leverich [292] Son of James⁷ Hervey Leverich [138] and Sarah Ann Webb

Jasper Strong Leverich (714) was born circa 1835 at Newtown, Queens, New York.^{1,2,3}

The 1850 U.S. Census recorded Jasper Leverich, age 15, at Manhattan, Ward 18, New York County, New York. His household included his widowed mother Sarah, age 47; and siblings William H., age 22; James, age 6; Ann M., age 12; Sarah, age 8; and Eliza, age 9.⁴

The 1860 U.S. Census recorded Jasper (identified by the census transcriber as Joseph S.) at Manhattan, Ward 16, District 2, New York County, New York. The household included Jasper's mother Sarah, age 52; and siblings Annie M., age 21; Eliza J., age 20; and Sarah, age 19.⁵

Jasper Strong Leverich was never married. He is single in the 1850 and 1860 census, and died in 1864 with no mention of a wife.^{6,7,8}

Jasper S. Leverich died 23 March 1864 at Manhattan, New York County, New York. He was buried at Newtown, Queens County, New York, probably at the Newtown Presbyterian Church cemetery. He was age 28, hence born c 1835-1836.

On 16 August 1870 William Leverich, a resident of New Orleans, Orleans Parish, Louisiana, transferred and conveyed his interest in his brother Jasper's estate to his mother and remaining living siblings.⁹
