Individual Narrative of Anna⁸ Maria Leverich [293] Daughter of James⁷ Hervey Leverich [138] and Sarah Ann Webb

Anna Maria Leverich was born circa 1838 in either New York City or New Orleans, Orleans Parish, Louisiana based upon her age in U. S. Census records .1,2,3,4

Anna M. Leverich was recorded in the 1850 U.S. Census of Manhattan, Ward 18, New York County, New York. Her household included her widowed mother Sarah, age 47; also siblings William H., age 22; Jasper, age 15; James, age 6; Sarah, age 8; and Eliza, age 9.⁵

Anna M. Leverich, age 21 born Louisiana, was recorded in the 1860 U.S. Census of Manhattan, Ward 18, New York County, New York. Her household included her mother Sarah, age 52; also siblings Jasper, age 25; Eliza, age 20; and Sarah, age 19.6

Anna M. Leverich was never married.

Anna M. Leverich joined the Fifth Avenue Presbyterian Church on 6 March 1862 in Manhattan, New York County, New York.⁷

Anna M. Leverich, age 31 born New York, was recorded in the 1870 U.S. Census of Newtown, Queens County, New York. Her household included her mother Sarah, age 63; her sister Sarah, age 29 and her husband George P. Wright; and her sister Eliza, age 30.8

Anna M. Leverich made a will 5 March 1878. The will mentions sisters Sarah A. Cox and Eliza Leverich of Newtown, Queens County, New York; a brother James H. Leverich residing at Guatemala, Central America; and a niece Adele Villars residing at New Orleans, Orleans Parish, Louisiana. The will was proven at the New York County, New York Surrogate.⁹

Anna M. Leverich, age 40 born Louisiana, was recorded in the 1880 U.S. Census of Newtown, Queens County, New York. Her household included her mother Sarah, age 72; and her sister Eliza, age 40.10

On 7 November 1883 Anna M. Leverich arrived at the Port of New York via the Ship Gallia, which had departed from Liverpool, England and Queenstown, Ireland.¹¹

Anna Maria Leverich died on 17 March 1887 at Manhattan, New York County, New York. She was probably buried at the Fifth Avenue Presbyterian Church in Manhattan. 12,13,14
