## Individual Narrative of Sackett<sup>8</sup> Leverich Jr. [327] Son of Sackett<sup>7</sup> Leverich [156] and Cornelia L. Duryee Husband of Mary Woodruff Fricke

Sackett Leverich Jr was born in March 1831 at Manhattan, New York County, New York.1

Sackett Leverich Jr, age 23, single, ship joiner, unmarried, boarder was recorded in the 1855 New York State Census of Brooklyn Ward 4, Kings County, New York.<sup>2</sup>

Sackett Leverich Jr married Mary Woodruff Fricke on 3 September 1857 at Brooklyn, Kings County, New York. 3,4,5

Mary W. Fricke was born in December 1838 in Manhattan, New York County, New York. Mary was the daughter of John A. Fricke. Her mother has not been identified.<sup>6,7,8</sup>

On 22 August 1862 Sackett Leverich Jr was enrolled as a private in the Civil War in Company D, 139th Regiment of New York State infantry. He was wounded twice during his service. He was mustered out 19 June 1865.9

Sackett Leverich Jr followed the trade of a carpenter. In his later years he had built up quite a trade in rustic work. 10

Sackett Leverich Jr, carpenter, was listed in the 1869 Brooklyn City Directory living at 290 Navy Street. 11

Sackett Leverich Jr, age 39 carpenter, was recorded in the 1870 U. S. Census of Islip, Suffolk County, New York. His household included his wife Mary, age 33; and his son Edward (Edwin), age 9.12

Sackett Leverich Jr, age 46 ship joiner, was recorded in the 1880 U. S. Census of West Islip, Suffolk County, New York. His household included his wife Mary, age 44; and his son Edward (Edwin), age 18.<sup>13</sup>

Sackett Leverich Jr, age 69, was recorded in the 1900 U. S. Census of Islip, Suffolk County, New York. His household included his wife Mary, age 62; and his son Edwin R., age 38.<sup>14</sup>

Sackett Leverich Jr died on 6 August 1905 at West Islip, Suffolk County, New York, at age 74. 15,16 He lived on Higbie Lane. Sackett Jr was buried at the Babylon Rural Cemetery in Babylon, Suffolk County, New York. 17,18

Mary Woodruff (Fricke) Leverich died 10 February 1906 in West Islip, Suffolk County, New York. She was buried at the Babylon Rural Cemetery in Babylon, Suffolk County. 19,20

Sackett Leverich Jr and Mary Woodruff Fricke had one child, who survived to adulthood.<sup>21</sup>

Edwin Robinson was born 30 September 1862 in Brooklyn, Kings County, New York, but lived most of his life in West Islip, Suffolk County, New York. Edwin married first Ruth E. Fricke 9 September 1892. Edwin married second Lucy Field 22 June 1914. Edwin died 24 April 1943 in West Islip. He was buried at the Babylon Rural Cemetery in Babylon, Suffolk County. 22,23,24
