

Individual Narrative of Martha⁸ A. Leverich [330] Daughter of James⁷ S. Leverich [160] and Hannah L. Fox

Martha A. Leverich was born circa 1839 at Brooklyn, Kings County, New York.¹ Martha's parents had relocated to Brooklyn from New Jersey circa 1838-1840, before moving back to New Jersey circa 1840, as per the Brooklyn City Directory.^{2,3}

Martha A. Leverich was never married. Her death record indicates that she was single.⁴

Martha A. Leverich, age 11 was recorded in the 1850 U. S. Census of Newark North Ward, Essex County, New Jersey. Martha's household included her parents James ad Hannah Leverich, ages 39 and 36 respectively. Also her siblings Matilda E. Leverich, age 14; William Leverich, age 8; John Leverich, age 6, and Charles Leverich, age 1.⁵

Martha A. Leverich, age 21, was recorded in the 1860 U.S. Census of Camden South Ward, Camden County, New Jersey. Martha's household included her parents James and Hannah Leverich, ages 51 and 44 respectively. Also her siblings Matilda E., age 24; Charles H., age 11; Mary L., age 9; and Alice, age 3.⁶

On 23 December 1869 Martha A. Leverich, single, became a member of the Tabernacle Methodist Church in Camden, Camden County, New Jersey. Martha was not found in the 1870 U. S. Census.⁷

Martha A. Leverich died on 21 November 1879 at Philadelphia, Philadelphia County, Pennsylvania.⁸ Martha was living at 948 North 6th Street in Philadelphia at the time she died. She was buried at Bethel Memorial Park in Pennsauken, Camden County, New Jersey.^{9,10}
