

**Individual Narrative of William<sup>8</sup> J. Leverich [331]  
Son of James<sup>7</sup> S. Leverich [160] and Hannah L. Fox  
Husband of Sarah A. (Sallie) Palmer**

William J. Leverich was born circa 1842 at Newark, Essex County, New Jersey, according to the 1850 and 1870 U.S. Census records.<sup>1,2</sup>

William J. Leverich, age 8, was recorded in the 1850 U. S. Census of Newark North Ward, Essex County, New Jersey. William's household included his parents James and Hannah Leverich, ages 39 and 36 respectively. Also his siblings Matilda E. Leverich, age 14; Martha A. Leverich, age 11; John Leverich, age 6, and Charles Leverich, age 1.<sup>3</sup>

William J. Leverich, age 26, farm laborer, was recorded in the 1870 U. S. Census of Stockton, Camden County, New Jersey. William is living in the household of his employer.<sup>4</sup>

William J. Leverich, age 31, single, farm laborer, was recorded in the 1880 U. S. Census of Stockton, Camden County, New Jersey.<sup>5</sup>

William J. Leverich married Sarah A. (Sallie) Palmer between 1880 and 1895 probably at Camden County, New Jersey. A marriage record has not been found. William is single in the 1880 U.S. Census. Sallie Leverich is listed as William's wife in the 1895 New Jersey State Census, which is the first record that mentions her.<sup>6,7</sup>

William J. Leverich was listed in the 1883 Camden City Directory, a farmer living at 1st above Burlington Pike.<sup>8</sup>

William J. Leverich was listed in the 1890 Camden City Directory, a laborer living at 2nd corner Mitchell in Cramer's Hill, a neighborhood in the City of Camden.<sup>9</sup>

William J. Leverich and his presumed wife Sallie were recorded in the 1895 New Jersey State Census of Stockton, Camden County, New Jersey. There are no Leverich children in the household. The household does include five Palmer individuals but does not indicate their relationship to Sallie.<sup>10</sup>

William J. Leverich died on 9 Oct 1896 at Stockton, Camden County, New Jersey.<sup>11,12</sup> He was buried at Coletown Cemetery in Coletown, Camden County.<sup>13</sup>

Sallie Leverich, age 39 widow, and her father John Palmer, were recorded in the 1900 U. S. Census of Vorhees, Camden County, New Jersey. There were no Leverich children in the household.<sup>14</sup>
