Individual Narrative of Mary⁸ L. Leverich [334] Daughter of James⁷ S. Leverich [160] and Hannah L. Fox Wife of James P. Cregar Wife of Stacy T. Gaunt

Mary L. Leverich was born on 12 March 1851 at Newark, Essex County, New Jersey.¹

Mary L. Leverich, age 9, was recorded in the 1860 U.S. Census of Camden South Ward, Camden County, New Jersey. Mary's household included her parents James and Hannah Leverich, ages 51 and 44 respectively. Also her siblings Matilda E. Leverich, age 24; Martha A. Leverich, age 21; Charles H. Leverich, age 11, and Alice Leverich, age 3.²

Mary L. Leverich, age 19, was recorded in the 1870 U.S. Census of Camden, Camden County, New Jersey. Her household included her widowed mother Hannah, age 52; her sisters Matilda, age 34, and Alice, age 13.³

Mary L. Leverich married James P. Cregar on 10 June 1872 at Camden, Camden County, New Jersey. Cregar was a resident of Philadelphia. They were married in the Third Street Methodist Episcopal Church.^{4,5}

James P. Cregar was born February 1847 in Pennsylvania. He was the son of Charles P. Cregar and Mary Ann Pidgeon.^{6,7}

Mary L. Leverich, age 29, and her husband James P. Cregar, age 32, were recorded in the 1880 U.S. Census of Philadelphia, Philadelphia County, Pennsylvania. They were living at 1851 North 8th Street. They had no children living in the household.⁸

Mary L. Leverich, age 49, lace cap maker, was recorded in the 1900 U.S. Census of Philadelphia Ward 28, Philadelphia County, Pennsylvania. living at 2135 Susquehanna Avenue. Her husband was not listed in the household, which was headed by Peter Weaver, age 42, and his wife Alice, age 42, Mary's sister. No children were listed in the household.⁹

James P. Cregar died 25 January 1902 in Philadelphia or Camden. He choked to death on a piece of meat stuck in his throat which he could not dislodge. James was living at 527 North Front Street, and was employed as a night watchman in the worsted mills at Front and Erie Streets in Camden.¹⁰

Mary L. Leverich married Stacy T. Gaunt on 10 September 1908 at Camden, Camden County, New Jersey.¹¹ They were married by the Rev. John W. Lyell, pastor of the First Baptist Church. Stacy was age 72 and living at 826 North 6th Street. He was widely known in Camden, where he was a well-known produce dealer. It was a second marriage for both individuals.¹²

Mary L. Leverich, age 58, and her husband Stacy Gaunt, age 73, were recorded in the 1910 U.S. Census of Camden, Camden County, New Jersey, living at 523 Vine Street. No other persons were living in the household.¹³

Stacy T. Gaunt died 2 January 1918 in Camden, Camden County, New Jersey. He was buried in Evergreen Cemetery at Camden.¹⁴

Mary L. Leverich, age 68, was recorded in the 1920 U.S. Census of Woodbury Ward 3, Gloucester County, New Jersey, living on High Street. Mary was a boarder in the household of Edward Sherman.¹⁵

Mary L. Leverich, age 71, was recorded in the 1930 U.S. Census of Woodbury Ward 3, Gloucester County, New Jersey living at 17 High Street. Mary was a roomer in the household of Jonathon Gallup.¹⁶

Mary L. Leverich, age 89, was recorded in the 1940 U.S. Census of Woodbury, Gloucester County, New Jersey, living at 27 East Center Street. Mary was a lodger in the household of Alice T. Brown.¹⁷

Mary L. (Leverich) Cregar Gaunt died on 28 November 1949 at Woodbury, Gloucester County, New Jersey, at age 98.^{18,19} She was buried in Evergreen Cemetery in Camden, Camden County, New Jersey. Mary had no children by either marriage.²⁰
