

**Individual Narrative of Alice⁸ Fredericka Leverich [335]
Daughter of James⁷ S. Leverich [160] and Hannah L. Fox
Wife of Peter Lyle Weaver**

Alice Fredericka Leverich was born on 22 March 1857 at Camden, Camden County, New Jersey.¹

Alice F. Leverich, age 3, was recorded in the 1860 U.S. Census of Camden South Ward, Camden County, New Jersey. Alice's household included her parents James and Hannah Leverich, ages 51 and 44 respectively. Also her siblings Matilda E. Leverich, age 24; Martha A. Leverich, age 21; Charles H Leverich, age 11, and Mary L. Leverich, age 9.²

Alice F. Leverich, age 13, was recorded in the 1870 U.S. Census of Camden, Camden County, New Jersey. Her household included her widowed mother Hannah, age 52; her sisters Matilda, age 34, and Mary L., age 19.³

Alice Fredericka Leverich married Peter Lyle Weaver on 20 July 1883 at Dudley, Camden County, New Jersey.⁴

Peter L. Weaver was born 31 August 1857 in Philadelphia, Philadelphia County, Pennsylvania. Peter was the son of Major David P. Weaver and Angelina Deets. For many years Peter had been the military editor of the Philadelphia Inquirer. He was a former member of the Second Infantry National Guard Pennsylvania (NGP). While serving through the labor trouble in Pittsburgh in 1877 he was shot through the left ankle and the face. He was also wounded by being struck with a brick. He was elected a Captain in 1882 and retired in 1887.^{5,6,7}

Alice F. Leverich, age 42, and her husband Peter L. Weaver, age 42, were recorded in the 1900 U.S. Census of Philadelphia Ward 28, Philadelphia County, Pennsylvania. They were living at 2135 Susquehanna Avenue. The household also included Alice's sister Mary L. Cregar. No children were listed in the household.⁸

Alice F. Leverich, age 50, and her husband Peter L. Weaver, age 55, were recorded in the 1910 U. S. Census of Springfield, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania. There were no other persons, including children, in the household.⁹

Peter L. Weaver died 20 July 1914 in Glenside, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania. He was buried at Cheltenham Hills Cemetery in Philadelphia, Philadelphia County, Pennsylvania.^{10,11}

Alice F. (Leverich) Weaver, age 63. was recorded in the 1920 U.S. Census of Abington, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania. Alice was a boarder in the household of Lorna A. Smith.¹²

Alice Fredericka (Leverich) Weaver died on 11 May 1931 at Abington, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania, at age 74.¹³ She was buried at the Cheltenham Hills Crematory in Philadelphia, Philadelphia County, Pennsylvania.¹⁴

Alice Fredericka Leverich and Peter Lyle Weaver had no children (see census records above).
