

## Individual Narrative of George<sup>8</sup> W. Elderd [352] Son of Hannah<sup>7</sup> Leverich [184] and John Elderd

George W. Elderd was born circa 1822 at Flushing, Queens County, New York.<sup>1,2</sup>

George W. Elderd married Anna Hamel circa 1844 at Manhattan, New York County, New York.<sup>3,4</sup>

Ann Hamel Elderd was born circa 1823-1824 in New York State. Her parents were James and Elizabeth ( - ) Hamel.<sup>5,6,7</sup>

George W. Elderd, age 28, was recorded in the 1850 U.S. Census of Manhattan Ward 13, New York County, New York. George's household included his wife Ann, age 26; and children Mary E., age 4; and John H., age 1.<sup>8</sup>

George W. Elderd, age 38, was recorded in the 1860 U.S. Census of Manhattan Ward 11 District 3, New York County, New York. George's household included in wife Ann, age 37; and children Mary E., age 14; William C., age 8; and Peter B., age 6.<sup>9</sup>

George W. Elderd, carpenter, was listed in the 1860 New York City Directory living at 282 Stanton.<sup>10</sup>

George W. Elderd died on 18 October 1895 at Manhattan, New York County, New York.<sup>11</sup> George was buried at Woodlawn Cemetery in the Bronx, then a part of Westchester County, New York. At the time of his death, George W. Elderd was a real estate agent living at 613 East 134th Street.<sup>12</sup>

George W. Elderd made a will dated 4 August 1886 in which he left his entire estate to his wife Ann, also making her the executor.<sup>13</sup>

Ann Hamel Elderd died 16 April 1899 in the Bronx, which was then part of Westchester County, New York. At the time of her death she was living at 1017 East 133rd Street. She was buried at Woodlawn Cemetery in the Bronx.<sup>14</sup>

George W. Elderd and Anna Hamel had four children according to census records, but two of which (Mary E. and John H.) are missing from Ancestry.com.<sup>15,16</sup>

William E. Elderd was born 27 November 1851 in Manhattan, New York County, New York. William married Therese Wolsey, widow Stewart 1 June 1892 in Manhattan. William died 1 January 1906 in Manhattan. William was buried at Woodlawn Cemetery in the Bronx which at that time was part of Westchester County, New York. William was recorded in the 1900 U.S. Census of New York County.<sup>17,18,19,20,21,22,23</sup>

Peter B. Elderd was born circa 1854 in Manhattan, New York County, New York. Peter was never married. Peter died 26 June 1882 in Manhattan. Peter was buried in the Woodlawn Cemetery in the Bronx, which at that time was part of Westchester County, New York. Peter was recorded in the 1880 U.S. Census of Manhattan.<sup>24,25,26</sup>
