

## **Individual Narrative of Susan<sup>8</sup> M. Taylor [510] Daughter of Ann Eliza<sup>7</sup> Leveridge [207] and Elias Osborn Taylor**

Susan M. Taylor was born 18 October 1837 in Manhattan, New York County, New York. The birthdate was calculated based upon Susan's age at the time she died, 18 years, 11 months, 16 days.<sup>1</sup>

Susan M. Taylor, age 17, was recorded in the 1855 New York State Census of Manhattan, New York County, New York. Susan was single living with her parents Elias O., age 52, and Ann Eliza, age 51, Taylor; and siblings Charles F., age 13, and John L., age 7.<sup>2</sup>

Susan M. Taylor married Joseph G. Taylor (relationship unknown) circa 1855-1856. Susan was single at the time of the 1855 census and she died in 1856.<sup>3,4</sup>

Susan M. Taylor died 3 October 1856 probably in Manhattan, New York County, New York. In June 1857 New York newspapers reported on a hearing regarding the probate of the Burdell estate. "Mrs. Ann Eliza Taylor testified that the Herkimer landlord Eli Taylor was at their house three weeks after her daughter's death, which was October 3." Susan was buried at Greenwood Cemetery in Brooklyn, Kings County, New York.<sup>5,6,7,8</sup>

Jospeh G. Taylor, widower of Susan M. Taylor, was recorded in the 1860 U. S. Census of Manhattan, Ward 13 District 4, New York County, New York. Joseph was living in the household of Sarah Leveridge Lamson, sister of Ann Eliza Leveridge Taylor, Susan's mother.<sup>9</sup>
