

**Individual Narrative of Elnathan<sup>7</sup> Leverich [194]  
Son of William<sup>6</sup> Leverich [68] and Aletta (unidentified)**

Elnathan Leverich was born circa 1808. He was baptized 16 May 1808, the son of William Leverich, at the Newtown Presbyterian Church in Queens County, New York. Based upon the process of elimination, this likely would have been William<sup>6</sup> Leverich Jr. [68] and his wife Aletta. Elnathan was likely named after his paternal grandfather. Elnathan probably died young. No further record of Elnathan has been found.<sup>1,2</sup>
